I intend this letter to be my complaint against twenty (20) Local Government Officers in the Township of Old Bridge, Middlesex County in accordance with Old Bridge Code § 145-11(A). Following are the elements of the complaint:

1. **State the point of the Local Government Ethics Law alleged to be violated.**

N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.6 and Code § 145-5 requires Local Government Officers to file annual Financial Disclosure Statements (FDS) on or before April 30th of each year.

Complainant has no interest in or relationship to this complaint greater than any other citizen or organization who wishes for all government officers and employees to comply fully with the Local Government Ethics Law.

No other action has been taken previously in an attempt to resolve this issue and this issue is not the subject of any pending litigation.



**Old Bridge Township Board of Ethics Meeting
October 17, 2011**

A meeting of The Old Bridge Township Board of Ethics was held October 17, 2011 in The Mayor's Conference Room in the Municipal Complex, One Old Bridge Plaza, Old Bridge, New Jersey

Roll call at 6:05p.m. showed the following members present: John Scalamonti, Andrew Strus, John Muir, Father Jonathan Toborowsky. Rabbi Yossi Kanelsky was absent. Board Attorney Brian Whiteman was also in attendance.

Minutes

Approval of Minutes from May 16, 2011

These minutes were moved to the next meeting for approval.

Old Business

Discuss William Flynn's Correspondence of Dismissal of Dr. Greenberg's Complaint.

Mr. Whiteman stated that Mr. Flynn was requesting that the complaint be dismissed because he believes that there was no conflict and also because Mr. Desai's son no longer works for the accounting firm. Dr. Greenberg was contacted and she does not agree to the dismissal. This board decided to accept the complaint and it is now time for this board to move to the hearing phase of the matter.

Mr. Strus stated that he wanted to move forward with this because he does not want to just sweep it under the rug. Mr. Strus asked that a date be set for the hearing.

Mr. Scalamonti asked if we can get the minutes from the OBMUA meeting where the legal opinion was given to Mr. Desai stating that there was no conflict.

Mr. Whiteman stated that those minutes would probably be part of the defense by Mr. Flynn.

Mr. Strus asked that the formal hearing be at the next meeting of the board.

Mr. Whiteman will send a letter instructing the parties to present to the board their list of witnesses or written defense at least ten days before the hearing.

Evaluation as to Individuals Required to File Financial Disclosures.

Mr. Strus requested that this be held over until the next meeting because he needs to find out further information on a matter related to this, which he does not want to make public at this time.

Rabbi Kanelsky Participation as a Board Member

Mr. Strus stated that the board will take up this matter once there is a new member appointed.

Rabbi Wernick Replacement

Mr. Strus stated that he has an individual named Edward Dever who is interested in serving on the Ethic's Board. Mr. Strus presented the board members with Mr. Dever's resume and asked that they be in agreement with presenting him to Council for consideration of the appointment.

Richard Greene Appeal

Mr. Whiteman stated that the State rendered their opinion and we sent in a clarification of the facts – we did not have a personal concern as to the result of the case, but it was important to factually clarify the record because the facts were very incorrect in the Judge's decision. We sent the clarification to the Local Finance Board and they affirmed what the Judge said. The appeal is over and the file can be closed.

Mr. Scalamonti asked then what Mr. Greene is alluding to in his email.

Mr. Strus stated that Richard Greene is making an allegation that Mr. Whiteman appealed the decision without the consent of the Ethics Board, which is totally false. Mr. Whiteman has only acted at our request, there were mis-facts and inconsistencies in the Judge's decision that were brought to our attention by Mr. Whiteman. The decision of this board was that the record should be factual and that was the reasoning in instructing Mr. Whiteman to file the appeal. Any indication that this board would act as a puppet for the Administration or anyone in this township, Mr Strus stated is an insult to himself and all members of the Board. This board has been totally unbiased in rendering decisions. Mr. Strus asked the board permission to respond to Mr. Greene's accusations at the next Council meeting with a statement that he will present to the members before it is read in a public forum. Mr. Strus believes that Mr. Greene could have contacted any of the board members to get the facts before making a public "blotch" against this board. Mr. Strus believes that this is a political ploy done in an election year.

Mr. Scalamonti stated that Mr. Greene is alleging that we appealed the decision.

Mr. Whiteman stated that we did not appeal the decision because we thought it was wrong, we appealed it because the Judge made factual inaccuracies, and we believed that the accurate facts should be considered as part of the decision.

New Business

Libertarian Party Complaint dated June 20, 2011.

Mr. Whiteman stated that the Libertarian Party filed a complaint with respect to the individuals who did not file Financial Disclosure forms.

Mr. Scalamonti asked why the Libertarian filed the complaint.

Mr. Whiteman stated that they are entitled to file a formal complaint. There are currently fifteen people who have not filed their disclosure forms. Mr. Whiteman stated that he has been in discussion with the attorney from the EDC because they believe that they do not have to file.

A motion was made to accept the complaint from the Libertarian Party by Mr. Strus and seconded by Mr. Muir. The motion passed on an all aye vote.

Mr. Strus stated that we have decided that they have to file.

Mr. Whiteman stated that we can send this to the Local Finance Board for them to make a legal decision on whether or not they are required to file.

Father Toborowsky stated that we decided that they are required to file because they have control of money.

Mr. Whiteman stated that the EDC can then file an appeal with the Local Finance Board.

Mr. Scalamonti stated that this board spent a lot of time on this list and if the EDC does not believe they have to file, let them appeal the decision and present their reasoning's on why not.

The Board directed Mr. Whiteman to send a letter to EDC counsel instructing him that the Ethics Board has decided that the members are required to file and if they want to appeal that, they can do so – to the Local Finance Board.

Father Toborowsky stated that we should not be trying to get into their heads as to why they didn't file. Send a letter to the persons who have not file telling them that they have 30 days to file or to appear at the next meeting telling us why they aren't filing.

Open to the Public

Chairman Strus opened the meeting to the public, seeing no hands Mr. Strus closed the public portion.

Schedule of Next Meeting

A motion was made to schedule a meeting for November 28, 2011 at 6:30p.m. in Room 201 in the Municipal Complex.

Adjournment

Mr. Scalamonti motioned to adjourn at 7:20 p.m. and seconded by Mr. Muir and so ordered on an all aye vote.
