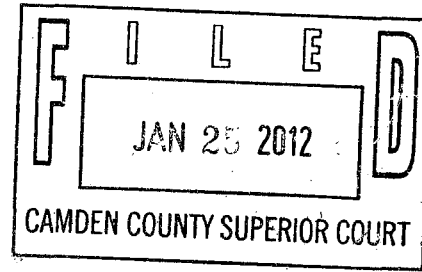



**THIS MATTER** having been brought before the Court by Walter M. Luers, Esq., of the Law Offices of Walter M. Luers, LLC by motion for an award of reasonable attorneys' fees against Defendants Borough of Gibbsboro and Township of Voorhees, and the Court having considered the papers filed by the Plaintiff and opposition papers filed by Defendants Borough of Gibbsboro, Anne D. Levy, Township of Voorhees, Jeanette Schelberg, Richard Taylor and Tracy M. Taylor, and having heard oral argument on January 13, 2012; and for the reasons set forth on the record on January 13, 2012, and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this  day of January, 2012

A. **ORDERED** that Plaintiff has partially prevailed in this matter and is entitled to an award of reasonable attorneys' fees and costs pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6* regarding his claims for production of mobile-to-mobile transmission data and Officer Taylor's shift log from Defendant Voorhees Township only; and it is further


B. **ORDERED** that Defendant Township of Voorhees only shall pay Law Offices of Walter M. Luers, LLC the total of **\$4,443.57**, consisting of \$3,375 in reasonable attorneys' fees, a 20% contingency enhancement of \$675, and costs of \$393.57; and it is further

C. **ORDERED** that the Verified Complaint is dismissed with prejudice as to the Borough of Gibbsboro and Anne D. Levy; and it is further

D. **ORDERED** that, as a result of the Court's *in camera* review, the arrest reports sought by Plaintiff from the Borough of Gibbsboro and the radio transmissions sought by Plaintiff from the Township of Voorhees are subject to a duly served and filed order of expungement and therefore shall not be disclosed; and it is further

E. **ORDERED** that Defendant Township of Voorhees shall pay counsel for Plaintiff within twenty days after service of this Order upon them; and it is further

F. **ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall serve a copy of this Order upon all Defendants within seven days of service of this order.
