

IT IS on this 11 day of June, 2013

A. ORDERED Plaintiff's Motion to Enforce Litigant's Rights is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**; and it is further

B. ORDERED Defendant shall amend its March 28, 2011 executive session meeting minutes by providing additional information regarding what occurred at that meeting, including whether the matter being discussed was a personnel matter or collective bargaining matter; and it is further

C. ORDERED that Defendant shall amend its March 28, 2011, May 30, 2012 and June 6, 2012 executive session minutes so as to include the location of the


meeting and Defendant shall do so in all such minutes prepared in the future; and it is further

D. **ORDERED** Plaintiff's request that the May 30, 2012 and June 6, 2012 executive session meeting minutes contain additional details is **DENIED**; and it is further

E. **ORDERED** that Defendants shall comply with paragraphs B and C of this Order within 15 days of the date of this Order if it has not already done so; and it is further

F. **ORDERED** that Defendant shall pay to Plaintiff his reasonable costs in making this application; and it is further

G. **ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall serve a copy of this Order upon Defendant within seven days of receipt of this order by Plaintiff.
