

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on December 15, 2014, following the entry of an Order to Show Cause on November 10, 2014; and at the time of the hearing, the Plaintiff, John Paff, was represented by Donald M. Doherty, Jr., Esquire; and the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office ("ACPO") was represented by the Atlantic County Counsel's Office, Elizabeth C. D'Ancona, Esquire, appearing; and the Court having considered the submissions of counsel together with their oral arguments; and the Court wishing to afford the ACPO sufficient opportunity to continue and conclude the criminal investigation which may contain documents accessible to the Plaintiff under the Open Public Records Act ("OPRA"); and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 17th day of DECEMBER, 2014, **ORDERED** that the ACPO shall advise Assistant County Counsel, Elizabeth C. D'Ancona, Esquire, on or before March 9, 2015, as to the status of the investigation, arising out of the City of Margate, which is the subject of this litigation; and that Ms. D'Ancona shall advise the Court and Mr. Dougherty, in writing by said date, regarding the status of the investigation and what documents, if any, she and her client deem accessible under the OPRA.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of the required communication from Ms. D'Ancona, the Court will then establish a schedule for further actions on the Plaintiff's petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served on opposing counsel within seven (7) days of service of this Order.
