On the above date and time, this Officer was dispatched to 502 Church Road for a reported female that was struck with a piece of wood by another female. Upon this Officer's arrival, I observed patrol vehicle 15 on location parked blocking the driveway. I observed Communications Operator O'reilly seated in her vehicle, which was parked in the driveway facing the roadway. This Officer exited marked patrol vehicle 4. As I walked over toward the residence, I observed Det. Hynes attempting to render aid to a female, later identified as [REDACTED] seated on the front steps who appeared to be bleeding from the head. Det. Hynes directed this Officer to bring over an oxygen tank and first aid kit from my patrol vehicle. I then administered oxygen to [REDACTED] and provided her with gauze pads to try and stop the bleeding. [REDACTED] would not allow this Officer to touch her head. [REDACTED] appeared to be upset. This Officer asked [REDACTED] what happened and she reported she was walking toward the house when she was struck in the head with a piece of wood by Communications Operator O'reilly. As [REDACTED] reported what had occurred, she gestured to a single piece of wood lying on the ground that was a few feet away from her. The piece of wood appeared to be a fire place log. [REDACTED] further reported that Communications Operator O'reilly called her a "Fucking cunt", prior to striking her with the piece of wood. The first aid and medic unit arrived on location and took over patient care. [REDACTED] was transported to Jersey Shore Medical Center due to her injury.

At this time, Sgt. Downs and Officer Torre arrived on location. Sgt. Downs requested Chief Williams to respond. Shortly thereafter, Chief Williams arrived. Sgt. Downs spoke with two persons who had reportedly witnessed the assault.

I spoke with Chief Williams who directed this Officer to bring Communications Operator O'reilly into police headquarters. This Officer escorted Communications Operator O'reilly to my marked patrol unit. I observed Communications Operator O'Reilly to have multiple woodchips on her sweatshirt she was wearing. The woodchips were located on her chest and left sleeve. I asked Communications Operator O'Reilly if she needed any medical attention and she denied it at that time. While enroute to police headquarters, without this Officer asking any questions or saying anything to Communications Operator O'reilly, she gave a spontaneous utterance. Communications Operator O'Reilly stated, "I didn't do anything, I was pushed down". At that time, Communications Operator O'reilly contacted her attorney via telephone. Communications Operator O'reilly advised this Officer that she did not wish to make any statements until consulting with her attorney. Communications Operator O'reilly did report that she did not ask for a lawyer because she was guilty, but because she has prior history with [REDACTED] that she wanted referred to in regards to this situation. Once at police headquarters, I advised Communications Operator of her Miranda Rights and waited with her until Capt. Larsen directed this Officer that she was free to leave. While with Communications Operator O'reilly, she made a complaint about pain to her left shoulder. I again, offered her medical attention and she refused any at that time. This Officer confirmed that the piece of wood reportedly used as a weapon was secured and marked as evidence. This case is pending further investigation.

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - THIRD DEGREE

It is, therefore, on 06/13/2014 **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that the defendant is sentenced as follows:
 On Amended Count One of Indictment 13-01-00188, defendant is sentenced to two (2) years Probation. This sentence shall run concurrent with the sentence imposed on Indictment 13-06-01490. Defendant is directed to comply with any and all terms and conditions as established by Probation. Defendant shall have no contact with the victim in this matter and shall turn over any and all firearms within five days to the defendant's brother. Defendant is not to possess any firearms/weapons.

Defendant is to pay monetary penalties as set forth on page two through Probation at a monthly rate determined by Probation.

Defendant is hereby ordered to provide a DNA sample and pay the costs for testing.

Any bail that has been posted in this matter is discharged.

The following is dismissed: Count Two of Indictment 13-01-00188 and S-2012-246-1524.

It is further ORDERED that the sheriff deliver the defendant to the appropriate correctional authority.
