Since [REDACTED] refused to voluntarily go to the hospital or even be examined by EMS personnel at the scene, telling me and the other officers that he would fight us, I took out handcuffs to help remove him from the kitchen. He resisted us physically, despite the officers telling him to stop resisting. With Cpl Turso and Ptl Pierson holding [REDACTED] arms, I got his hands cuffed behind his back. Cpl Turso and I began to take him from the kitchen. [REDACTED] kicked toys and furniture, tried to lunge toward EMS personnel, and tried to headbutt me. I had my left arm hooked around [REDACTED] right arm, and since I could not reach the pepper spray on the left side of my duty belt, I punched him in the face with my right hand in an effort to control him. Cpl Turso, Ptl Pierson, and I got [REDACTED] out of the room and into the back of Ptl Pierson's patrol car, and Ptl Pierson took him to Jersey Shore Med. I confiscated a blue pill that was in [REDACTED] possession. It was a blue oval shape and turned out to be prescription Zolof. I put it in evidence at TFPD.

I responded to the Executive Inn [REDACTED] for a report a 16 year old male subject who had ingested a large

I responded to the Executive Inn, [REDACTED] for a report a 16 year old male subject who had ingested a large quantity of assorted pills. En route to the call county dispatch advised the caller, the 16 year old's mother, warned that her son would fight police. I arrived and encountered the subject, identified as [REDACTED] standing in the main living area of the unit. He appeared agitated as well as disoriented. His mother, [REDACTED] was very upset and was pleading with [REDACTED] to cooperate and accept help. It became clear [REDACTED] would not acquiesce and stated several times that if I touched him he would resist. Also present in the apartment was [REDACTED] 2 year old sister who was lying contentedly on the bed. It was determined [REDACTED] had ingested approximately 30 Advil gel caps, 5 Zoloft pills, 4 Xanax pills, 4 Zicam pills, 1/2 a pill of Siboxin and a number of Vitamin B tablets.

Cpl. Turso and Sgt. Duane arrived as did Tinton Falls First Aid and Medics. We offered [REDACTED] a final chance to cooperate willingly and he declined. Sgt. Duane attempted to handcuff [REDACTED] at which point he began to resist. I administered a headlock while Sgt. Duane and Cpl. Turso forced [REDACTED] arms behind his back and handcuffed him. As we were escorting [REDACTED] outside as he continued to resist forcing Sgt. Duane to strike him in the face with a closed fist (see Sgt. Duane's supplemental). We were finally able to get him outside and he was placed in the rear of my patrol car.

I transported [REDACTED] to Jersey Shore Medical Center with Cpl. Turso accompanying. Medics met us at the hospital. [REDACTED] had calmed significantly by the time he was admitted as the pills he'd consumed began to significantly effect him. Following his assignment to a room in the pediatric wing I was relieved of supervision by Sgt. Duane who advised me to return to the borough.

[REDACTED] was charged with unauthorized possession of prescription medications and also for being under the influence of same. I completed a Juvenile Complaint form, Pedigree Information form and Case Initiation sheet all of which were submitted to Sgt. Trocchia upon completion. I also completed a Use of Force report.

Sgt. Duane attempted to notify [REDACTED] by phone in an effort to apprise her about the charges against [REDACTED] however, she did not answer. I attempted to call as well and left a voicemail when she did not answer.

The Professional Responsibility Unit of the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office has completed its review and investigation stemming from your civilian complaint that you filed with our office in January of 2011. Prior to coming to any conclusion, it was our desire to speak with your son, so that we could gain his perspective of the underlying incident. Towards that end, the assigned detective, Patsy Petro, made considerable efforts to obtain your son's statement, to no avail. I also addressed letters to you requesting that you make the necessary arrangements with Patsy Petro. You ultimately chose not to cooperate with this investigation, which is your prerogative.

Nevertheless, based upon our review of all of the information at our disposal, there is insufficient evidence to proceed with any further criminal investigation into the actions of the above officer. As such, our file is now closed.
