Narrative Title : Main Narrative

I responded to the listed location for a report of an assault. Upon my arrival, I was approached by a female, which was later identified as [REDACTED]. She reported that her son was assaulted by his Uncle, Wayne Bauer. The female was obviously upset and was irate about the incident. After calming her down, I began talking to her son, [REDACTED].

I asked him what had happened and he reported that he went to the F.C. Kerbeck Dealership in Palmyra to pick up his cousin, [REDACTED] for lunch. He then stated that they traveled from her work place to the Taco Bell restaurant located on Rt.73 in Pennsauken. He stated that his cousins phone rang and she began arguing with the caller, which was her father, Wayne Bauer. He stated that after her conversation on the phone, Wayne was at the passenger side door of his vehicle taking his daughter out of the car. He stated that shortly thereafter, Wayne got into the passenger seat and began arguing with him.

I asked [REDACTED] what the argument was about and he said that he was not sure but believed it had something to do with street drugs. He stated that his uncle then punched him in the nose twice after yelling at him. He further stated that there were two witnesses to the incident that were inside of the restaurant. One a male and the other a female.

I was able to locate the male witness, Michael McInerey [REDACTED]. I spoke with him in reference to the incident and he reported that he was walking inside of the restaurant entrance when he heard an argument. Upon looking out, he observed a male inside a car arguing with another male that was standing outside of the vehicle. He stated that he did not observe anyone being assaulted. He described the male standing outside the vehicle as: w/m wearing a blue uniform.

I also spoke with the female witness, Monica Ann Leiniger, 26 Township Line Rd., Elkins Park, Pa. [REDACTED] and cell [REDACTED]. She reported that she had parked her vehicle directly next to [REDACTED]'s. She stated that she overheard an argument between two males where one was saying, "leave her alone." She described the male as: w/m, stocky build, clean shaven, no glasses. She further stated that she observed that male pointing his finger at the others face. However, she also stated that she did not see anyone being punched or assaulted.

I walked back out and by this time the first aid squad had arrived on location and were tending to [REDACTED]'s injuries. I observed a small laceration on the bridge of his nose after the Emt's finished cleaning it. He was then transported to Our Lady of Lourdes Medical Center for further medical treatment.

I advised [REDACTED]'s mother, [REDACTED], of the complaint procedures through the municipal court for simple assault and issued her a case number for the incident.
