

**PITTSGROVE TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 06-2015**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 74, PUBLIC PEACE AND SAFETY, OF
THE MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSGROVE, SALEM
COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the current New Jersey State statute supersedes Chapter 74 of the Pittsgrove municipal code; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Pittsgrove deem it in the best interest of the Township to amend their municipal code.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Pittsgrove, County of Salem, State of New Jersey that Chapter 74 Entitled Public Peace and Safety is hereby repealed and of no further force and effect.


This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage and publication in accordance with law.
