Dear Mayor Moore:

Please be advised that a special meeting was held Thursday, February 25, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. at the Commercial Township Building. As you are aware this meeting was scheduled to go over various complaints, which were forwarded to my office from four different township employees.

Based on the issues in these complaints, which I have attached for your review, you can see that they are directed towards you. As we discussed over the telephone you were unable to attend the meeting and receive these written complaints. As the other township committee members were able to view the complaints at the scheduled special meeting, I have attached for you copies of the complaints so you may also review same.

As I explained to you the township committee ruled last night that I was to follow up on these complaints with an investigation with regards to the merits of these complaints. Therefore, as is consistent with the Commercial Township rules and regulations, I will be interviewing the alleged victims first and gathering factual information. I will then schedule a time to meet with you to go over your response to these allegations.

Also as we agreed and as the committee recommended you promised to refrain from contacting any of the township employees and/or visiting the township building until this investigation can be completed. If you fail to honor this promise we agreed that this could cause discomfort for anyone who has made a complaint against you and would also be uncomfortable for you.

I thank you for your cooperation in this matter and ask if you have any questions to not hesitate to contact my office. Also if you need anything at the township contact me and I can communicate on your behalf.
