We have reviewed the verified petition and affidavits submitted in the above captioned matter, as well as records available to us related to this matter. From this review, it has been determined, based on our understanding of the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:52-1 et seq., that an objection exists to the relief sought by this petitioner as more fully set forth below.

The objection(s) noted herein is subject to your confirmation pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:52-24 and the exercise of your discretion as to whether or not it constitutes "grounds for denial."

Petitioner fails to include required information. (N.J.S.A. 2C:52-7).

Petitioner fails to include the required statement(s). (N.J.S.A. 2C:52-8a).


